Guidelines for the Online Regular exams December 2020-January 2021.

1. Examinations of Semesters II to VI of the Gen. LL. B. (3 years) course and of Semesters II to X of the B.L.S. / LL. B. (5 years) course shall be conducted for the students of the Academic Year 2020-21.
2. These exams shall be conducted between **25th December to January 2021.**
3. The Timetable for these Regular exams shall be shared in shortly.
4. The exam shall be of the entire syllabus as prescribed by the University of Mumbai.
5. The college has already shared with you the username and password for the regular examination to be conducted on the online mode.
6. The exams shall be held through **online mode.**
7. **The Question paper pattern for the exam:**
 - a. 20 (Compulsory) Multiple Choice Questions for a duration of 30 minutes for 30 Marks
 - b. 10 (Compulsory) descriptive Questions for a duration of 60 minutes for 30 Marks
 - c. Medium: English/Marathi
8. Students must make requisite arrangements to appear for the online examination. (i.e. Smartphone/ Laptop/ Desktop/ any other gadget/ Internet Connectivity). We further recommend that the Students maintain a backup device for the examination. The software works at its optimum best on desktops or laptops, mobile phones can be used in the absence of desktops or laptops.
9. Students must ensure that they make themselves aware of the syllabus, paper pattern, timetable and the technical platform used by the college.
10. MOCK TESTS (PRACTICE EXAMS) of 10 SAMPLE MCQs each shall be conducted before the MAIN EXAM.
